# Competition Rules

# Dragon Taekwondo Tournament

## Forms

Forms will be divided by age, rank, male and female as follows:

Age Devisions: (4-5) (6-7) (8-9) (10-11) (12-14) (15-17) (18-32) (33+)

Belt Devisions: (White, Yellow, Orange) (Green, Blue, Purple) (Red & Brown) (Black)

Competitors will compete 2 at a time for forms competition. 5 judges will pick a winner by a show of hands, with the majority win. Two 3rd places will be awarded for forms. Selected based on beauty, grace, rhythm, focus, and technique. Intention: All 5 judges will be from 5 different marial arts schools.

All black belt forms divisions will be double elimination, along with recieving statues for both forms & sparring

# Sparring

Sparring will be divided by age, rank, male and female as follows:

Age Devisions: (4-5) (6-7) (8-9) (10-11) (12-14) (15-17) (18-32) (33+)

Belt Devisions: (White, Yellow, Orange) (Green, Blue, Purple) (Red & Brown) (Black)

Male and Female competitors will be seperated. Demonstration matches allowed with parent & coach/instructor permission

All color belts will spar 2 one-minute rounds with a 30 second rest period.

Black belts will spar 2 90-second rounds with a 30 second rest period.

### **EQUIPMENT:**

Safety equipment for sparring is mandatory! Participants must provide there own headgear, chest protector, shin/instep pads, fist/forearm pads, mouthpieces, and support cup for males. No jewelry allowed, and finger and toe nails must be trimmed.

### AREAS FOR SCORING:

HEAD: Controlled foot contact only, NO hand

techniques to the head are permitted.

11 & Younger No head contact 12 & Older Light head contact

BODY: This includes the area covered by the chest

protector. Points will be awarded for effective punch or foot strikes.

#### VALID SCORES:

One point shall be awarded for a legal foot technique or punch executed with proper balance to the body.

Two points shall be awarded for a legal foot technique to the head, or a spin kick to the body.

Three points shall be awarded for spin kicks to the head

Corner judges will determine sufficient force for awarding of the point, i.e. techniques must be delivered with enough power to satisfy the corner judges that a point should be scored.

## WARNINGS:.

- Any competitor that executes a kick to the head area that results in a minor injury shall receive a 1 point deduction
  - Any competitor that executes a kick to head that results in bleeding or innability to finish the match shall be disqualified
    - No Grabbing -
      - No Holding -
    - No escaping contact by turning the back -
  - No stepping out of bounds with both feet to avoid contact
  - No attacking with an unauthorized part of the body (elbow, knee, head etc.)
    - No attacking unauthorized areas \_ (groin, leg, etc.)
    - No intentional falling to avoid contact -
    - No attacking the head, neck or face with hands -
- No uttering undesirable remarks or unsportsman like conduct by coaches, athletes or any individual associated with the athlete
  - No gesturing to celebrate a score -
  - Pushing is allowed if followed by a kick -
- No pushing opponent to the ground or out of bounds -
